Today, we deliver humanitarian, development, and human rights assistance in more than 40 countries worldwide.


## People in Need Philippines

Since 2013, we have worked alongside communities in the Philippines to support those most vulnerable to disasters, poverty, and conflict.

Our work focuses on **Emergency Response and Recovery, Climate Resilience, and Civil Society and Inclusive Governance**. From responding to Typhoon Yolanda (Haiyan) to assisting communities affected by the Marawi conflict, we continue to invest in long-term recovery and resilience-building, helping communities become safer and stronger.

## Emergency Response and Recovery

### EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES (EIE)



The Philippines sits along the Pacific Ring of Fire, making it prone to typhoons, floods, earthquakes, and volcanic eruptions. These disasters often disrupt schools and put children’s education at risk.

To help children continue to thrive academically, they need coordinated support from families, communities, and schools, along with care for their mental, emotional, and social wellbeing.

### Education in Emergencies ensures:

-  Learning continues
-  Schools are safe
-  Children are protected
-  Psychosocial well-being is supported
-  Schools are better prepared for future disasters

## What we’ve done over the last 12 months



**Restore Learning** by providing teaching and learning kits, replacement of damaged materials and printers, establishment of temporary learning spaces, and all weather learning kits.



**Make School Safe** by supporting in clearing and performing minor repairs, providing tables and chairs, improving water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH), and supporting schools used as evacuation centers.



**Strengthen school** preparedness by updating contingency plans, prepositioning essential supplies, implementing pre-approved school-based financing, and training community learning facilitators.



**Protect and Support Learners** by enhancing Child Protection in Emergencies sessions, PFA training for teachers, school-based psychosocial programs, and strengthened reporting and referral systems.
